RULES FOR THE CAMPERS

- Arrival time is from 12:00pm on Friday 28th July. Latest arrival time is 8:00pm
- On arrival at the park please follow the signs for Festival Camping.
- For access to the Festival Camping Area you will need to have your eticket ready to exchange for wristbands.
- Each person must wear their wristband at all times. This will allow security to identify you as festival campers.
- If you are bringing a motorhome or caravan you will need to purchase a permit which must be displayed at all times.
- You must park your vehicle in the designated area. Please note, you will not be able to park beside your tent so you will have to carry your tent and equipment to your pitch. There will be no drop-offs by the gate, you must head to parking and unload from there.

Additional Information

- Bring a torch with replacement batteries and bulbs. There is no artificial lighting in the field after 2:00am.
- You are **not** permitted to have open fires or candles.
- Camping BBQs are permitted as long as they are off the ground and supervised. Do not dispose of hot coals on the ground in the Festival Camping Area as you may start a fire!
- Strictly no foil BBQ's will be permitted even if they are positioned off the ground.
- If you do any cooking then this should be done outside your tent.
- Please ensure you keep your pitch tidy and remove any rubbish from your pitch. There is a fenced area for rubbish. Rubbish bags will be provided.
- Please remember that there will be young children staying in the same area as you, therefore noise must be kept to a minimum and all music must be off by midnight.

- Caravans and tents will be in separate areas in the camping field. The **only** exception to this is if you are camping with small children and wish them to camp in a tent beside your caravan.
- If you consume alcohol, please do so in a responsible manner and be aware of others around you.
- No dogs are permitted.
- There are toilet and shower facilities provided in the camping area.
- Do not leave any valuables in your tent. Marvellous Festivals will not accept liability for any loss or damage to your property.
- The management reserve the right of access and are empowered to ask you to vacate the premises at any time, should you breach any of the terms and conditions, endanger the lives of others or have a disregard in respecting others' property, privacy and space.
